Cloud storage for saving, organizing, accessing, and sharing files

What is Dropbox? Dropbox is a cloud storage service. It keeps files online so you can reach them from an internet-connected computer, tablet, or smartphone instead of relying on only one device.

Who Created It and How Old Is It?

Creators: Drew Houston and Arash Ferdowsi. **Founded:** 2007. **Public launch:** September 2008. In 2026, Dropbox is about 19 years old as a company and 18 years old as a public service.

What Can You Do With Dropbox?

- Store documents, photographs, videos, and other files online.
- Create folders, back up important files, and synchronize changes across devices.
- Share a file or folder by sending a link; recipients can often view or download it without a Dropbox account.
- Work with others and restore certain deleted files or earlier file versions, depending on your plan.
